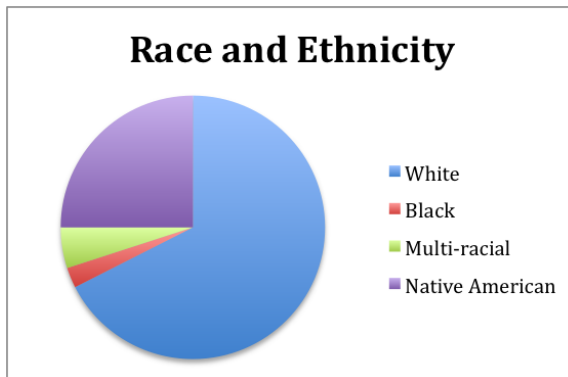


The Winter Sanctuary Quantitative Data Report

Data reflects Nov. 8, 2010- February 9, 2011

The Winter Sanctuary was established in 2008 and since then the number of guests served has increased each season. A season is November-April. Season 1 represents 2008-2009, season 2 represents 2009-2010, and season 3 represents 2010-2011.

23 of our guests during the 2010-2011 season have been men*, **10** have been women, and **12** have been children.

In 2010 The Winter Sanctuary opened to serve women and women with children. Women and children made up **48%** of the guests served in season. **3**.

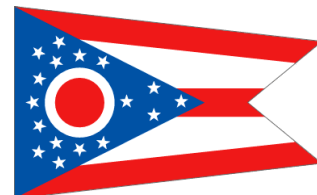
Most of the people we serve are homeless for the first time. In fact, close to **80%** have reported that they have been homeless for less than month. With this knowledge volunteers ensure to create a sensitive atmosphere to alleviate any stress or fear our guests may be experiencing.

We are making a difference in the state of Ohio!

35 guests are residents of Ohio

31 guests are residents of Knox County

3 were out-of-state, **7** failed to report their residency



Many of the volunteers of The Winter Sanctuary go above and beyond to serve the guests. In the past volunteers have advocated for guests' needs and were able to secure pro-bono health care from willing community members. One guest, for example, received a free eye exam and pair of glasses from Dr. York, a local optometrist. In addition, volunteers help guests secure permanent housing.

Nearly **33%** of guests have secured permanent housing since the shelter was established in 2008

15% guests secured either part-time or full-time employment during the 2010-2011 season.

*As part of our non-discrimination policy The Winter Sanctuary shelters transgendered guests according to the way he or she identifies him or her self. We served one transgender guest who identified himself as male.
